Athletic Hall of Fame Criteria for Selection

1. The nominee, either living or deceased, has made a significant contribution at Ross High School or beyond.
 2. Athletes: Candidates must have graduated from Ross High School a minimum of ten (10) years prior to being eligible for induction into the Hall of Fame. The credentials of the nominee may be based upon physical achievement, provided such honors are in the field of athletics. Examples would be:
 - a. Outstanding contributions/accomplishments to the Ross High School Athletic Program.
 - b. Recognition at a state level or participation in a state final.
 - c. Honors won at district/sectional level.
 - d. Outstanding accomplishments in post high school athletics.
 3. Coaches: A nominee must be a former coach who has distinguished himself/herself by demonstrating exceptional leadership, character, and achievement during his/her tenure at Ross Local Schools. The nominee must have coached at Ross for at least 5 years. Coaches must be retired from the sport they are nominated for at least 3 years.
 4. Administrator: Must be no longer employed by the Ross Local School district. The nominee must have been a loyal supporter of the Ross Athletic Program. The nominee must have made significant contributions to the athletic program during his/her tenure.
 5. Community Member: Nominees must have made ongoing and outstanding contributions to the betterment of the athletic programs at Ross High School.
- A nominee from these groups should not only signify athletic achievement, but be a person of high moral character and integrity. Background information, such as felonies, may disqualify a person from becoming a nominee.
